

Other than for the above incident there were no major incidents reported during the two days. 70 % -80 % of postal voters had cast their votes yesterday. Compared to the previous election there is a drop in the numbers. Generally, voting was held in a peaceful atmosphere and it could be considered due to the steps taken by the Election Commissioner to send special Officers to selected centers. We hope that the rest of the voters will cast their votes today.

With just 7 days for elections on 17th it will be PAFREL's Endeavour to ensure that peace will prevail during the coming week and on election day and the post election period, and we expect that support will be given to the Election Commissioner and the Elections Department by the Police, Political Leadership, their supporters, civil organization and the general public to conduct the election in a free and fair manner.
